The Joint Collaborative Committees (JCC) Co-Chairs Committee meetings provide a forum for cross-committee discussion, promote strategic alignment with JCC Principles, advance core committee mandates and provide oversight, direction and create alignment on shared initiatives.

Through leadership from each organization (Doctors of BC and the Ministry of Health), the Physician Services Committee (PSC) provides guidance, monitors activities, and oversees the work of the JCCs.

The PSC and Doctors of BC Board approved <u>3 Year JCC Aligned</u> <u>Strategic Plan</u> has identified the following focus areas: (1) Strengthen JCC alignment processes to create capacity for the JCCs to address emerging issues; (2) Align JCC Physician Leadership offerings across the committees; (3) Alignment of Priority Populations; and (4) Implement a cross JCC measures system across the committees.

The JCC co-chairs welcomed Eugene Johnson as the new SCC co-chair and Shana Ooms as the new SSC co-chair. The committee thanked Ryan Murray, outgoing SSC co-chair, and recognized his valuable contributions.

PSC/JCC Collaborative Event - Fall 2024

Tanya Lorenz and Liana Silver, Physician Services Committee (PSC) Secretariat, presented ideas for the PSC/JCC 2024 Workshop Event. The co-chairs agreed to use the Quintuple Aim as an overarching lens to discuss two priority areas: cancer care and mental health and substance use.

Ministry of Health and JCC staff will work to develop a purposeful agenda and co-facilitate the event.

Indigenous-Specific Anti-Racism (ISAR) Update

An update was provided on the Provincial Indigenous-Specific and Anti-Racism (ISAR) Forums and the Doctors of BC Board appointed physicians to the provincial Physician Specific Committee.

A request was approved to support the engagement of 20 medical professionals in advancing an equitable process and structure to inform the ISAR and Cultural Safety (ISAR & CS) "Physician Champions" initiative.

Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Discussion

The committee supported enhancing the EDI physician engagement and consultation strategy and making it accessible to more physicians through collaboration with the Doctors of BC Inclusion, Diversity, and Equity Advisory Committee, led by Dr Faisal Khosa.

The committee suggested connecting with the Diversity Equity Inclusion Provincial Working Group to review previous engagement outcomes and engage with health authorities and Medical Staff Associations to leverage existing EDI resources.

Advancing Alignment for Maternity

The co-chairs are supportive of exploring an aligned approach for JCC maternity/perinatal work. It was recommended that existing maternity groups and committees be inventoried to best utilize the current structures rather than creating a new advisory group.

PSC Priorities Discussion

The discussion focused on PSC identified priorities, which include surgical care, cancer care, mental health and substance use, and seniors' care. The cochairs discussed the role of the JCCs in supporting these health system priorities and where the JCCs can provide real value in the system.

JCC Combined Events - 2025

The committee approved the opportunity to combine three independent JCC events, the FPSC Summit, SSC Symposium, and JCC Showcase, into a cohesive two-day event. The date is to be confirmed for 2025.

BC Physician Integration Program (BC-PIP) Update

Dr Ian Schokking provided an update on the BC Physician Integration Program and requested a decision on the reallocation of funding.

As of March 31, 2024, UBC Continuing Professional Development issued 789 proofs of completion to participants.
